- This rebate is available only to income-qualifying customers of the following electric utilities: Barton Village Electric Department and Jacksonville Electric Company.
- Heat pump model number must be on this list to qualify: <https://ashp.neep.org>
- \$2,000 incentive will be applied either as a payment to the contractor performing the Home Performance with ENERGY STAR project or as a direct check to the customer upon project completion.
 - If the Home Performance with ENERGY STAR has not yet been completed, the \$2,000 incentive will be paid to the contractor performing the Home Performance with ENERGY STAR. An agreement between the contractor and the customer must include the following:
 - Scope of work
 - Specified work start date not exceeding 6 months after date of heat pump installation
 - Signatures from both the customer and the contractor
 - If the Home Performance with ENERGY STAR has already been completed, the \$2,000 incentive will be paid as a direct check to the customer. Certification of Home Performance with ENERGY STAR must include:
 - Completion date within 6 months of the heat pump installation date
 - Written notification from Efficiency Vermont that the contractor has submitted a Home Performance with ENERGY STAR rebate application, or
 - Written notification from Efficiency Vermont that the Home Performance with ENERGY STAR project has been completed
- VPPSA reserves the right to modify the incentive value should the heat pump installation and weatherization project total cost the customer less than \$2,000.
- One rebate per household.
- Limited funds available. Rebates are offered on a first come, first serve basis.
- Home Performance with ENERGY STAR must be completed at the heat pump installation address.
- VPPSA reserves the right to conduct field inspections to verify installations.
- VPPSA will not be responsible for any tax liability that may be imposed on the customer as a result of payment of rebates.
