Weatherization

To qualify for the \$100 weatherization rebate, please provide documentation that you have done one of the following:

- Completed a Home Performance with Energy Star project with Efficiency Vermont
- Received weatherization through the Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) since 2005 or are currently enrolled in WAP
- Received a 2011 or newer Residential Energy Standards (2011 RBES) certificate
- Had a blower door test performed with a maximum measured Air Changes per Hour (ACH) of less than 5 at 50 Pascals

- Controlled air leakage and updated ventilation improves indoor air quality and can help ease asthma and allergy symptoms.
