  - Completing a Home Performance with EnergyStar
  - Weatherization through the Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) since 2005 or are currently enrolled in WAP
  - 2011 or newer Residential Building Energy Standards (2011 RBES) certificate
  - Blower door test with maximum Air Changes per Hour (ACH) less than 5 at 50 Pascals
- One rebate per each qualifying exterior condenser heat pump unit.
